METHODS:

MFL

The ASNT made MFL a separate method. The MFL committee has developed the training outlines for level I, II, and III. The Certification and Management Council (CMC) is currently developing the level III examination. The CMC is the governing body responsible for the development and administration of the level III examinations and the ASNT Central Certification Program (ACCP). The MFL committee is currently working on the MFL Question and Answer Booklet and has approximately 60 questions specifically relating to Magnetic Flux Leakage of AGST bottoms.

PUBLICATIONS:

SNT-TC-1A

The **ASNT SNT-TC-1A *Guidelines for the Training and Certification of Nondestructive Testing Personnel 2006 edition*** went through ballot resolution and will be re-balloted soon.

CP-105

The **ASNT Standard *Topical Outlines for Qualification of Nondestructive Testing Personnel 2006 Edition*** is in the ballot resolution stage within the ASNT committees and when that process is complete and will be submitted for public review.
