This working group has been disbanded after the publication of ISO 1998-6:2000, *Petroleum industry – Terminology – Part 6: Measurement*

4 MEETINGS

ISO/TC 28/SC 1 last met on 19-20 November 1998 in Paris, France. At the last plenary meeting of ISO/TC 28, resolution 17 was adopted:

"ISO/TC 28 accepts the report of ISO/TC 28/SC 1, presented by the Secretary, Dr. Thiault, and as detailed in 28 N 2084. ISO/TC 28 notes that SC 1 has completed its work programme but agrees that the subcommittee shall not be disbanded and remains in place on a care and maintenance basis for its standards."

No correspondence has been received by the Secretariat since the last plenary meeting, except a letter from the US representative, Mr. Paul D. Hobson, announcing that he would no longer participate in this activity.

In the meantime, ISO 14532, Natural gas – Vocabulary, was published on 2001-08-09.

If a next meeting is needed, it will be organised when appropriate (see below).
