3. Specific areas of concern or progress

ISO 13879, ISO 13880 and ISO/TR 13881: the sales of these standards are difficult to measure; the standards are sold by ISO/CS in Geneva as well as all national standards institutes around the world. At the London meeting, November 2002, it was agreed that Keith Seyde from BSI would find out the BSI sales figures to have at least an indication.

ISO/TS 29001: the aim was to publish this standard at the latest June 15, exactly 6 months before the end of the ISO 9001:1994/2000 transition period. Unfortunately this date couldn't be reached. During the development of the project, ISO rules were carefully followed and checked at any time when necessary with the Central Secretariat in Geneva.

After finalization of project 29001 in WG 2, the draft circulated for voting as document N 830 in TC 67, together with documents N 828 and N 829. The results were circulated by TC 67 (2003-04-28):

- N 835 - Ballot results on 67 N 828, i.e. proposal to extend the scope of project 29001 to include the "petrochemical" industry, within the approved scope of ISO/TC 67
- N 836 - Ballot results on 67 N 829, i.e. proposal to develop project 29001 for publication as an ISO Technical Specification
- N 837 - Ballot results on 67 N 830, P&ngi – Sector specific quality management systems – Requirements for product and service supply organizations
