Resolution 3 (Beijing, 2008)

ISO/TC 67 accepts the previous meeting report (N 1007R) and Report of the Secretariat (N 1018-1021) as distributed by Secretariat, noting that Bahrain has now joined TC67 as a P member.

ISO/TC 67 requests its Management Committee to review the SC6 Process Guide and determine if it can be used as a template for work within other TC67 subcommittees and with other standards developing organizations.

Resolution 11 (Beijing, 2008)

ISO/TC 67 approves the revised SC7 target dates as presented in document 1027 Add 1, and decides to reallocate the Offshore Containers project, 10855, to SC7, requesting the WG responsible for this project to liaise with TC 96, Cranes, and TC 104, Containers.

ISO/TC 67 requests its P-members either confirm their existing or nominate new technical experts to TC 67/WG2 to work on the next edition of TS 29001, with an initial meeting planned for 22 January, San Antonio, USA. WG2 Secretary is requested to make a call for experts.

ISO/TC 67 approves the WG8 target dates as presented in document N1032, Add 1, requests ISO/CS review the CD draft and comments in order to make a recommendation to the work group on the most applicable ISO deliverable, and approves the new title of project 21457 to “Petroleum, petrochemical, and natural gas industries – materials selection and corrosion control for oil and gas production systems”, noting that as the CD comments are reviewed a further revision to the title may be necessary, possibly including the terms “guidelines” or “recommendations”.

TC 67 approves the work programme of WG 10, “LNG installations and equipment” as presented in N 1033 Add 1, and approves 28460 to go to DIS stage, skipping the CD stage, and requests that the TC67 P members nominate experts to PT4, Materials and PT6, LNG Transfer Arms.
